Meals are cooked onsite by our own Catering staff. If you wish to enquire about arranging school meals for your child, please contact the School Office. Meals cost £2.75 per day and are invoiced for weekly on parent pay

You should still apply to see if you qualify for Free School Meals if your child prefers food from home or has dietary constraints that mean they do not eat. Pupils eligible for Free School Meals also receive additional funding from the government which helps the school to ensure that their pupils can reach their full potential both academically and socially.

School Contributions

Minibuses

The school runs three mini-buses to enable pupils to regularly access the community. Contributions received from parents help to cover the running costs of these three vehicles. Contributions are currently £1 per week and are charged termly.

Cookery / Sensory Resources Money

Cookery monies are used to buy ingredients for the pupils to use during their timetabled cookery sessions and their endeavours are often sent home for you to enjoy as well. For our younger pupils who do not do cookery sessions the money is used to buy sensory resources such as shaving foam, bubbles and scented oils for massage. Contributions are currently £1 per week and are charged termly.

Healthy Tuck

Healthy Tuck is funded by the government for pupils in Key Stage 1. Pupils in Key Stage 2 and above are encouraged to bring in fruit or vegetables for tuck time which follows morning break.. Tuck time follows the morning break.

Voluntary contributions go towards the running of the school mini buses and providing cookery/sensory resources, the school feels that these enrichments offer good value for money. Please contact the school office if you would like to discuss any concerns regarding payment. If insufficient contributions are received the school may not be able to undertake some of these activities.

Voluntary contributions will be uploaded onto parent pay termly.

Swimming at Goldenstones

Some pupils in the upper part of the school have the opportunity to go swimming at Goldenstones pool on a Friday morning. The current cost of £3.00 per pupil covers the entry fee and tuition by a qualified instructor. This is invoiced half termly on parent pay
